GRANTS SUPPORT HUMAN AND SOCIAL SERVICES IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

VICTORIA - More than 300 local organizations in 29 communities in Central, Interior and Northern regions of British Columbia will benefit from more than \$8.1 million in community gaming grants for human and social services and public safety announced Rich Coleman, Minister of Housing and Social Development.

Some of the groups that will receive funding include the Nawican Friendship Centre in Dawson Creek, the Central Okanagan Emergency Shelter Society in Kelowna and the Prince Rupert Marine Rescue Society.

This round of funding provides 814 groups in the province with approximately \$24.9 million in community gaming grants to support local organizations.

Effective April 1, 2010, the Province combined two gaming grant programs (bingo affiliation and direct access) into the Community Gaming Grant program. This amalgamation ensures all community groups have fair and equitable access to gaming funds. It also streamlines and simplifies the grant application, review and approval process for applicants and the Province.

In total, the Province has budgeted \$120 million for gaming grants in 2010-2011, \$7.4 million more than last year. The grants will fund approximately 6,000 organizations that support people in need, public safety, youth arts and sports, education and parent and district advisory councils.

To date, approximately \$54 million has been allocated to gaming grants for 2010-2011. The Province considers applications for community gaming grants four times a year, with each intake devoted to a specific sector.
