Receive support to assist parents in advocating for their children

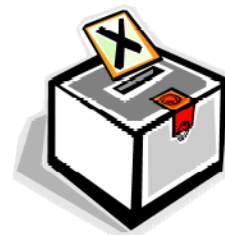
Have access to parent education opportunities, at a reduced rate, including spring and fall conferences that share parent leadership and involvement knowledge
